you see and use.

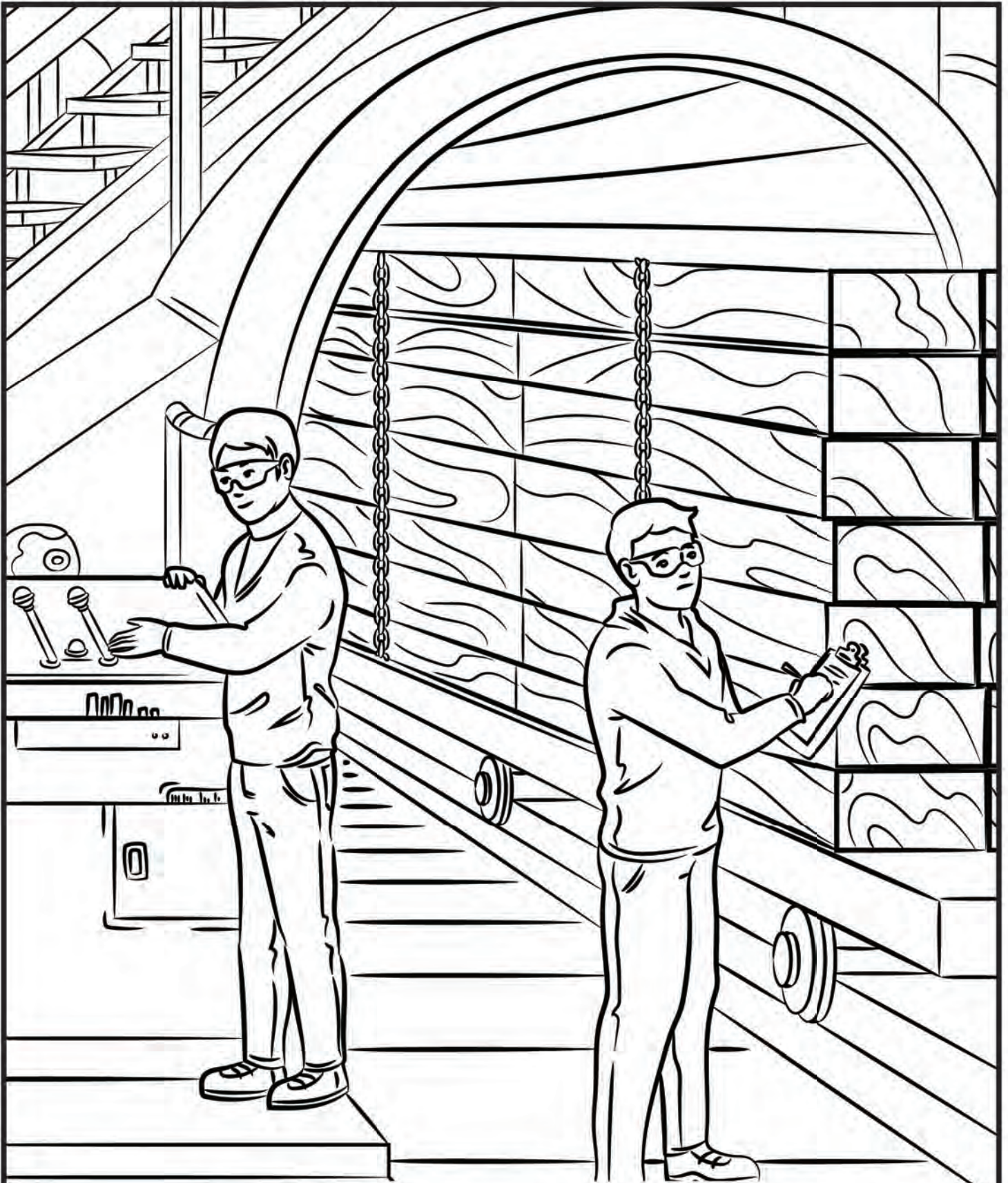




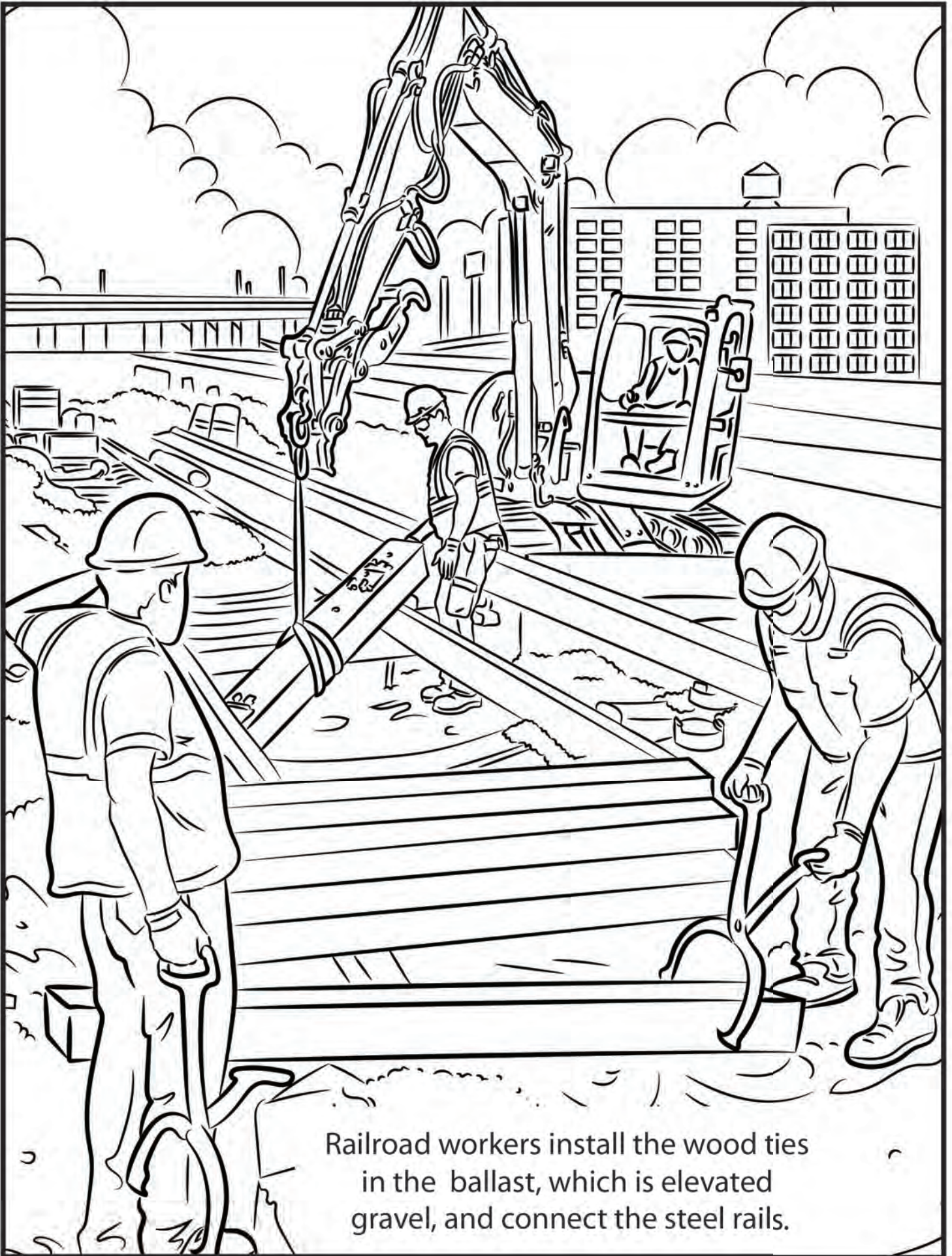
Railway tracks use wood to sustainably transport trains across America on millions of wood ties.



Sustainability means the wood tie lasts so long a new tree can grow big enough to replace it.



Wood ties are protected with preservatives so they remain strong enough to hold the track firmly in place for the train.



Railroad workers install the wood ties in the ballast, which is elevated gravel, and connect the steel rails.

Railroad workers are the only ones
who should ever be on a track,
for your safety do not walk on
tracks or cross train bridges.



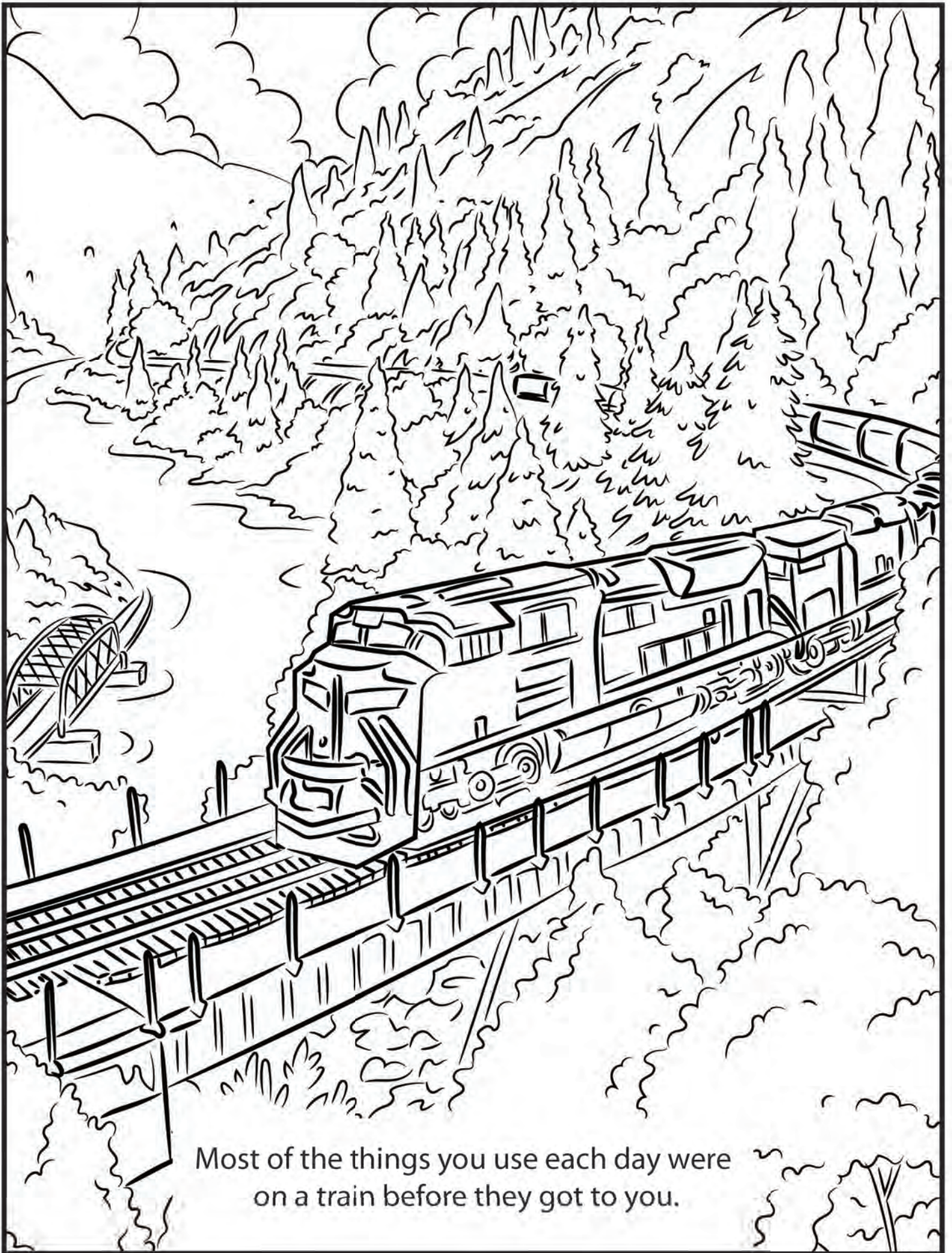

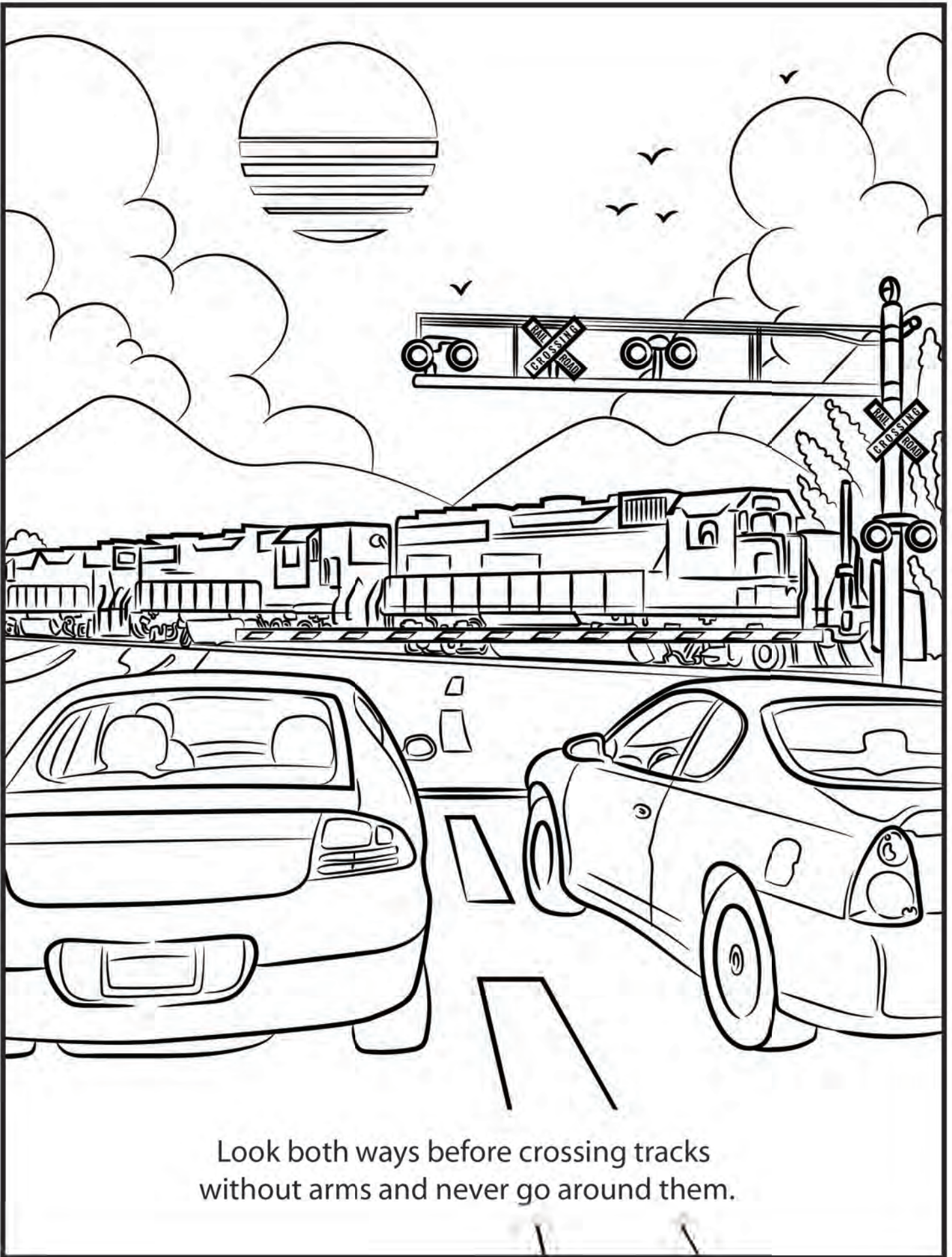

on a train before they got to you.

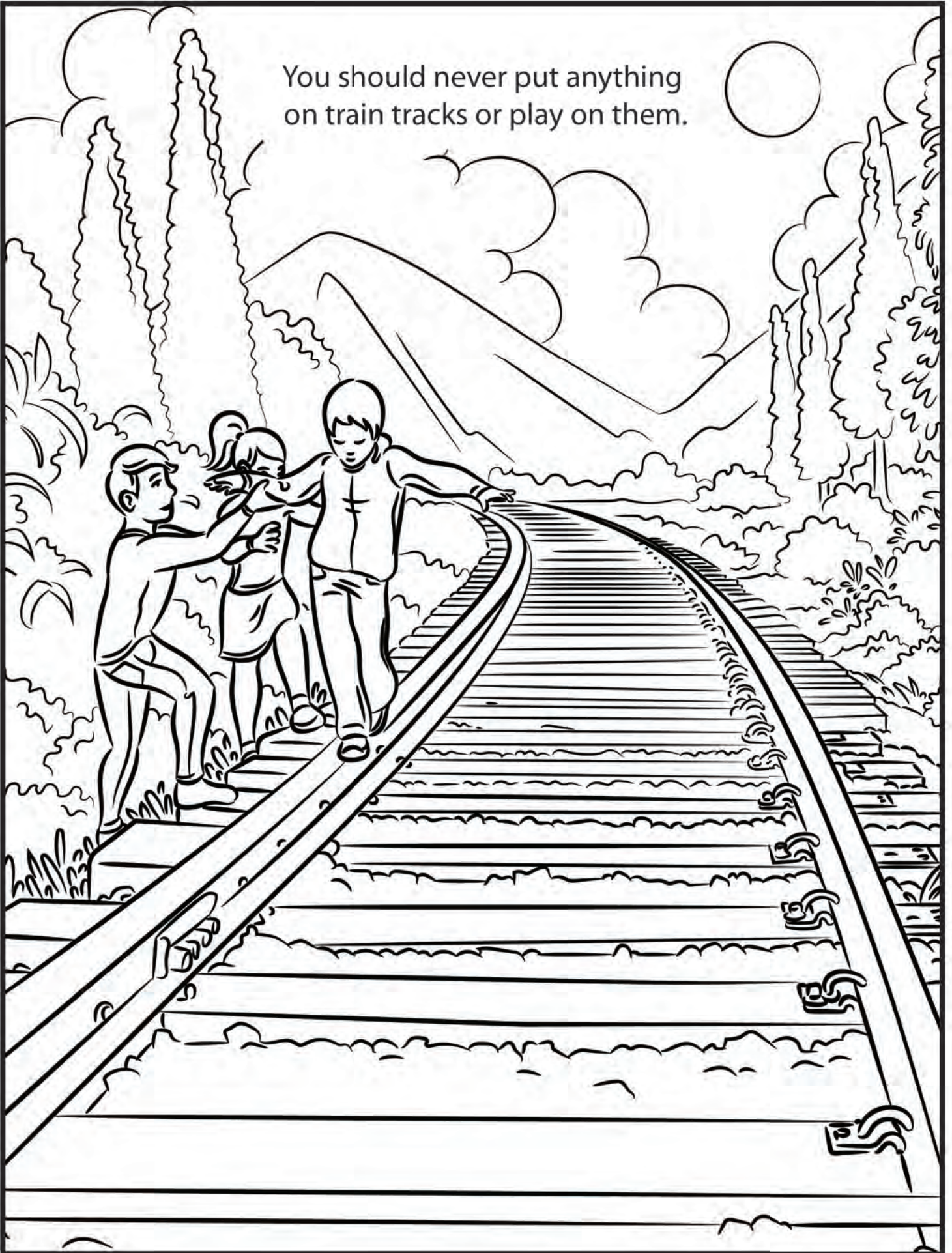


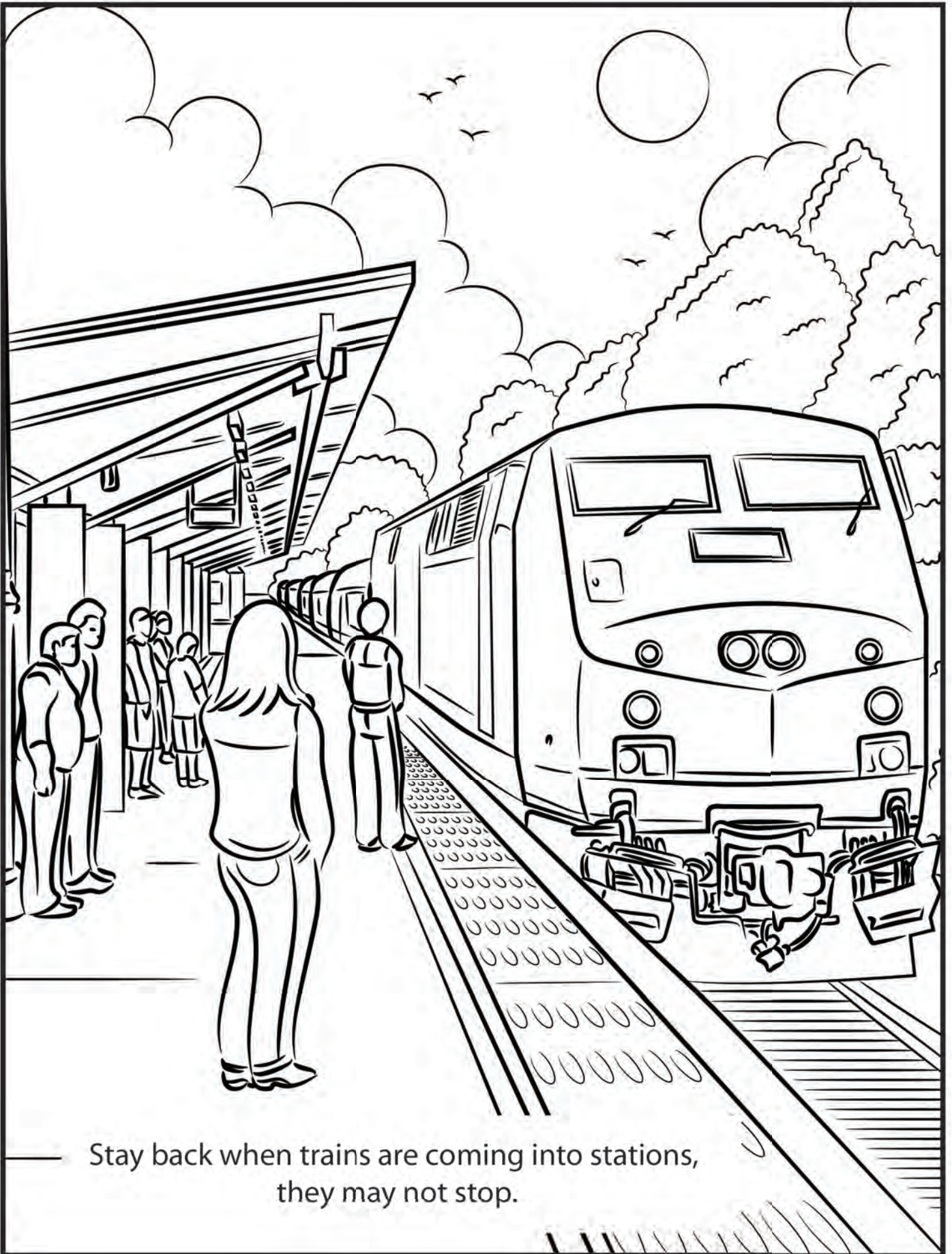
Look both ways before crossing tracks
without arms and never go around them.



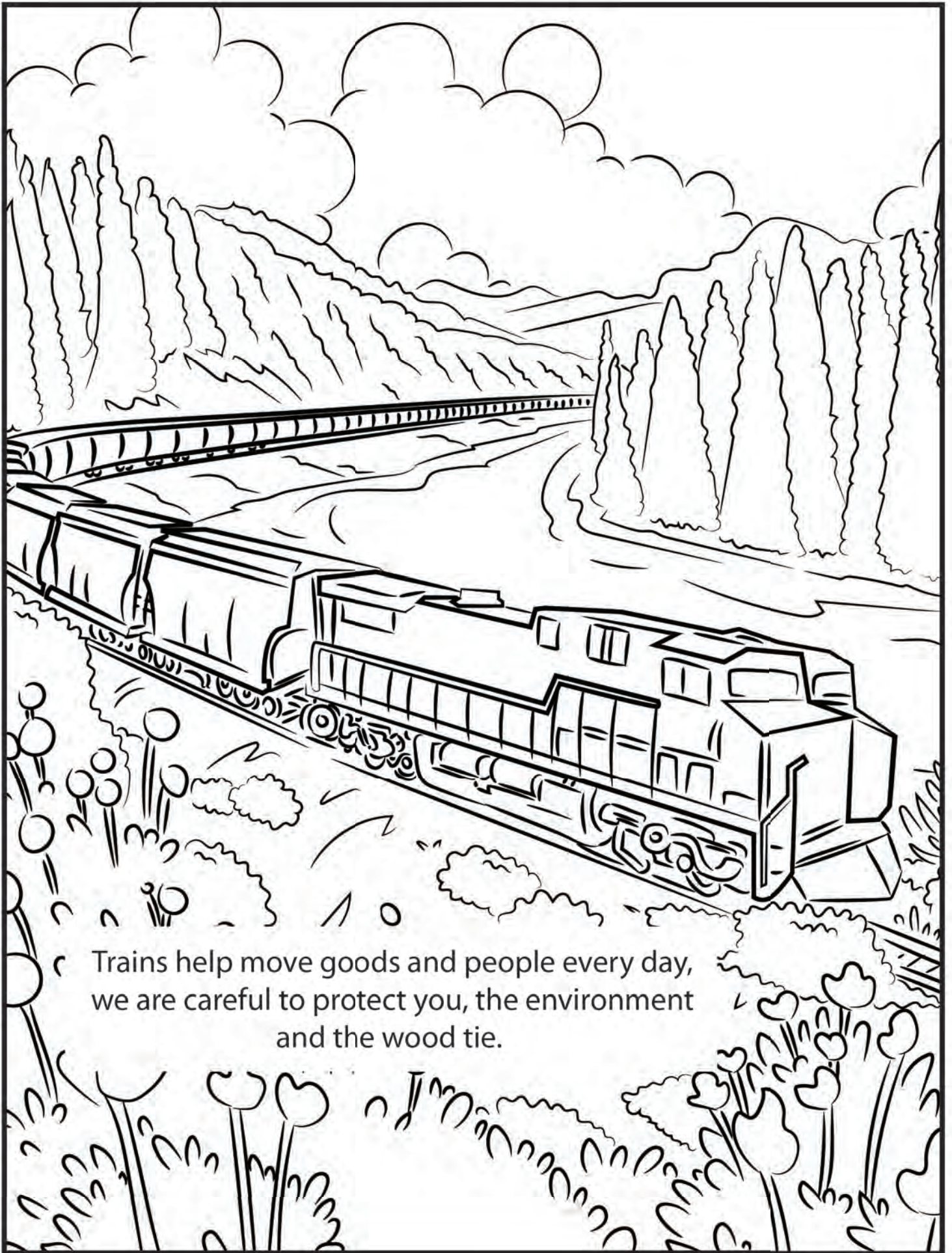
From transporting people to moving goods to your neighborhood train tracks are important.
